# DEFINE YOUR SOURCE OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROP

### SET A BUDGET

Bathroom remodels can range from simple refreshes to full-scale renovations. A clear budget will help you prioritize where to splurge and where to save.

#### Typical Budget Breakdown

- Plumbing Fixtures (toilets, faucets, sinks, showers, tubs) 25-35%
- Labor & Installation 40-60%
- Finishes & Materials (tile, countertops, lighting) 15-25%
- Unexpected Expenses Add an additional 10%

#### **Money-Saving Tips**

- Keep the plumbing in its current location to avoid costly relocations.
- Invest in high-quality fixtures that last longer and save water.
- Order materials in advance to avoid delays and rush shipping fees.



Cutting corners in these areas can create major problems down the road.

A bathroom remodel takes careful planning. Here's a general timeline:

- 1. Plan & Budget (2-4 weeks)
- 2. Hire Contractors (2-6 weeks, depending on availability)
- 3. Order Fixtures & Materials (2-8 weeks, allow time for shipping!)
- 4. Demolition & Prep (1-2 weeks)
- 5. Plumbing & Electrical Work (1-3 weeks)
- 6. Install Fixtures & Finishes (1-2 weeks)

#### Choosing the Right Pros

- 1. Ask for references and check reviews.
- 2. Ensure they are licensed and insured.
- 3. Get a detailed quote and timeline.
